

Alexandru Dragomir - „On the possibility of Gettier cases for conceivability-based modal knowledge”.

„Gettier cases are used to show that having a justified true belief is not sufficient for knowledge. Modal epistemology tackles questions regarding the sources of modal knowledge and what offers justification for beliefs about what is possible or necessary. Part of the tradition in modal epistemology is to consider conceivability as a guide to metaphysical possibility: if an agent can conceive that P, then the agent is justified to believe that P is metaphysically possible. In this presentation I will discuss the possibility of constructing Gettier cases for a tripartite, conceivability-based, definition of modal knowledge.”
